

I was also reminded of God's goodness through you in 2015! Your gifts to Wisconsin Lutheran High School have demonstrated your passion to help teens grow in their knowledge and love for Jesus. Maybe your motivation came from the first part of Hebrews 13:5, which reads: *"Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, 'Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.'"*

Your gifts in 2015 has helped WLHS in so many ways. I will recap a few.

- WLHS experienced its largest growth since 1994 in large part due to \$756,000 given by donors for tuition assistance.
- Our students took 214 Advanced Placement tests in eight different areas. 88% of WLHS students scored a three or higher on those tests, while the state average was 69%.
- 94% of seniors who came in below grade proficiency at WLHS were accepted to a four- or two-year college or decided to join the military.
- Our pastors and teachers shared the love of Christ, in a loving and caring atmosphere. The Holy Spirit moved 10 students to be baptized as a result!

On behalf of the faculty and staff at WLHS, and especially those of us in the Mission Advancement office, please accept our sincere thanks for helping make 2015 a year of blessings for our students. You will find your 2015 yearly support attached.

There is work to be done again in 2016. We know God will continue to guide and shape our students, the future leaders of our great nation, our churches and our communities. We pray you will answer the call once again to be a blessing to WLHS. God grant you a blessed new year, full of faith and hope.


